## Recognizing Our Volunteers

Volunteers can be nominated for any of these categories:

- **Citizen Of The Year** recognition requirements
  - Been a resident and volunteered in Carol Stream for all of 2023
  - You may complete the nomination form with the nominee
- **Special Citizen Of The Year** recognition requirements:
  - Resident of Carol Stream, and volunteered for the past 5 years
- **Judges Recognition Honor** requirements:
  - Must live outside of the village limits for this entire year
  - Volunteer service must have been provided to an organization(s) within Carol Stream

To recognize, simply:

- Reach out to the volunteer and ask them to accept the nomination.
